



This is an update and reminder concerning the Buckeye Science & Engineering Fair (BSEF).

Students in grades 9-12 who are interested in competing in the Buckeye Science and Engineering Fair (BSEF) will need to create an account on ProjectBoard. Students will need to select “Science Day” to get started. To successfully complete the sign up, students will be required to submit/upload the following elements of their project:

- Properly completed ISEF Forms
- Written Final Report
- Quad Board (a template will be provided)
- Video (15 minutes maximum). Students may use a slide deck as part of their presentation.
- Registration payment (\$50 per student, this will appear once you have submitted to BSEF)

Registration for BSEF will open on February 1, 2023, and the registration will close on February 15, 2023. On February 1st a “Submit” button will appear at the top of the student’s project in ProjectBoard. Students will use this button and select which event(s) they are registering for.

The 1st round of judging will take place virtually. On or about March 15, 2023, the OAS will announce the list of students advancing to the 2nd round of judging that will take place on Saturday, April 1, 2023 via Zoom. Judging for the second round will be a Zoom call with a panel of judges. Specific details will be provided to each of the 2nd round finalists.

The 2023 ISEF Finalists representing the BSEF will be announced on April 3, 2023. These ISEF Finalists will have an opportunity to attend the Regeneron International Science & Engineering Fair (ISEF) 2023 in May. The BSEF judge committee will select a total of 6 projects to attend ISEF
