

## Biography – Andy Savage

Dr. Andy Savage is an assistant professor of biology at Tiffin University. He received his B.Sc. in Biology with a specialization in Marine and Aquatic Biology from Bowling Green State University in 2013 and his Ph.D. from the University of Louisiana at Lafayette in 2020. Andy currently teaches human anatomy and physiology and evolutionary biology. His research primarily focuses on understanding the interactions and adaptations of burrowing animals in estuarine environments. He has also conducted research on skeletal morphology in fish and histopathology of arthritis in humans. He has served as a reviewer for regional conferences and is a member of the American Society for Ichthyology and Herpetology.
