

Manuscript Copy Editing Fee – Effective January 1, 2025

The Ohio Journal of Science (OJS) need for copy editing support has increased considerably. To address this need, beginning 2025, all manuscripts submitted and then accepted to OJS will be assessed a \$150 copy editing fee.

As in the past, by the time of publication, either the first or the corresponding author must be a member of the Ohio Academy of Science (OAS). The Professional Membership cost is \$75 per year. If neither the first or the corresponding author is an OAS member at the time of publication, an additional charge of \$50 per printed page will be charged. Obviously, article publication costs are reduced substantially by becoming an OAS member.

The Ohio Journal of Science is an interdisciplinary, open access scientific journal. Open access scientific journals commonly charge \$1000, \$2000, or even more than \$3000 to publish articles. By comparison, beginning 2025, the total OJS article publication cost will typically be equal to or less than \$225 (membership and copy editing charges combined). The Ohio Journal of Science is committed to pursuing all possible means to minimize publication charges and thereby provide a low-cost venue for authors to submit quality scientific manuscripts.
